

ATTENDANCE

Only one absence is allowed in summer school. There are no excused absences. The second absence will result in dismissal or denial of credit. Students are required to arrive on time for all classes. Students who arrive 15 or more minutes late to class will be counted as absent for that class.

LATENESS

Late to class three times will count as one absence. A late is when a student arrives after the start of class but is less than 15 minutes late. If you are more than 15 minutes late to class, it will be counted as one absence.

DISCIPLINE

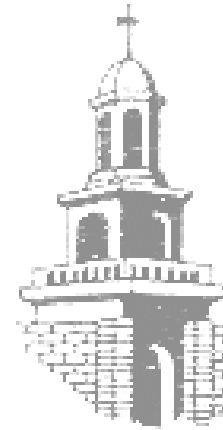
